Our ropes course at Lutherdale is designed for all adventure seekers. With trained and certified staff overseeing every step, we prioritize safety while providing an exciting experience. We believe in "challenge by choice," tailoring the course to accommodate all abilities. While all campers will participate in the low ropes course and team building challenges, the Climbing Tower is an add-on experience for any campers that have completed grades 3-12.

DESIGNED FOR FAITH EXPLORERS

2025 PRICING AND SCHOLARSHIPS

We strive to ensure camp is accessible to all!

We are proud to offer a tiered-pricing system in which each camper family self-selects the price that works best for them. Selections are always confidential and all campers receive the same high-quality experience regardless of their selection.

We work hard to offer our summer staff competitive wages and keep up with rising costs. Since we recognize that our camper families also face rising costs, we keep our prices as low as possible to make camp accessible for all. All tiers are subsidized from the true cost of camp. We also offer full and partial scholarships to all families who need them. We never turn campers away!

Tier III more closely accounts for the true cost of camp.

Tier II is our partially subsidized tier for those who can pay a little more but still cannot afford the true cost of camp.

Tier I is our most subsidized tier and does not reflect the true cost of operating summer camp programs.
